SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER ~ ~ THE PRESENCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT ~ ~ We have a unique episode in the Acts of the Apostles today. A whole roomful of people are baptized with the Holy Spirit before they are baptized with water! The verb used—“the Holy Spirit ‘fell’ on them” (Acts 10:44)—is characteristic of the way the Spirit works throughout the book of Acts: powerful and surprising. Though this “baptism” is not the normative way the New Testament describes baptism, it is still a good reminder today that the Holy Spirit is not controlled by whether or not we pour water, but rather that our sacramental signs reveal the presence of the Spirit at work among us. And we have a double reinforcement of how this work is accomplished from a Letter and a Gospel bearing John’s name. It is love, self-sacrificing and self-giving love, that manifests the Spirit of Jesus in our midst. It is love that is the greatest of commandments. FACTS OF LIFE

She Learned She Survived an Abortion When Her Birth Mom Told Her: "Your Life is a Miracle"

Claire Culwell, was thrilled when she met her birth mother for the first time. Adopted as an infant, she learned that her birth mother, Tonya, was only 13 years old when she became pregnant. At their second meeting, Culwell thanked her birth mother for choosing life. But those two words had an impact that she did not suspect. Tonya, with tears in her eyes, confessed that she had had an abortion but Claire survived. Now, Claire Culwell is sharing her miraculous story in a new book, "Survivor: An abortion survivor's surprising story of choosing forgiveness and finding redemption," which is available since April 27, the Catholic News Agency reports. "My hope is that as people read this book, they will know what abortion is, they will know what it does, and they will act on being the hands and feet of Jesus, being that support system for women." Culwell told EWTN Pro-Life Weekly. Culwell explained that she was adopted as a baby by loving Christian parents. As a young adult, she said she watched her sister, who also was adopted, meet her birth mother and expressed a desire to do the same. Not her choice alone, Tonya said her mother pressured her to have the abortion and eventually she gave in. After the abortion, however, she said she began to suspect that she still was pregnant. Later, a doctor confirmed that she had been pregnant with twins and the abortionist had missed Claire. "I can grapple all day with the fact that my life was spared and my twin's wasn't, and what am I missing, and I'll never understand," she told EWTN. "The only person that understands is the God that wrote this story for me, and He wrote it perfectly, and I can trust in that."


