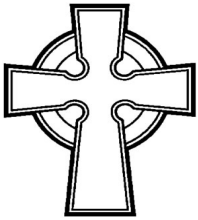
We encourage all to read and reflect on the Biblical passages that will be proclaimed at Masses on next week.

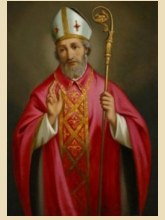
Saint of the Week **Saint Anselm, Bishop, Confessor,** **Doctor of the Church; (Doctor Magnificus)**

Born: 1033, Aosta, Italy,

Died: April 21, 1109, Canterbury,
United Kingdom,

Canonized: 1163, by Pope Alexander III,
Full name: Anselmo d'Aosta,

Feast Day: April 21, **Attributes:** His mitre, pallium, and crozier; his books; a ship, representing the spiritual independence of the Church.



Anselm of Canterbury, also called Anselm of Aosta after his birthplace, and Anselm of Bec after his monastery, was a Benedictine monk, abbot, philosopher and theologian of the Catholic Church. Despite his lack of recognition in this field in his own time, **Anselm** is now famed as the originator of the ontological argument for the existence of God and of the satisfaction theory of atonement. He was proclaimed a *Doctor of the Church* by a bull (common but unofficial name given to certain decrees issued by the Holy Father) of Pope Clement XI in 1720.
