Reflections on Today's Readings:



FOCUS: Jesus, our path to salvation, calls us *brother and sister* and commands that we do **the will of God**. From the beginning, God has promised his people redemption. His love is stronger than sin and prevails over evil. Jesus comes to us to embody that love and set an example for us to follow. In doing God's will, he shows us the way to the Father and calls us to do the same on our journey to eternal life.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: In Genesis, sin enters the world as Adam and Eve yield to the serpent's temptation. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians urges believers not to be discouraged: our earthly dwelling fades, but life in the Lord is eternal. Mark's Gospel shows Jesus being described by the scribes as "possessed." Jesus responds with a promise that doing the will of God makes us his brothers and sisters.

Jesus, thank you for being my friend.



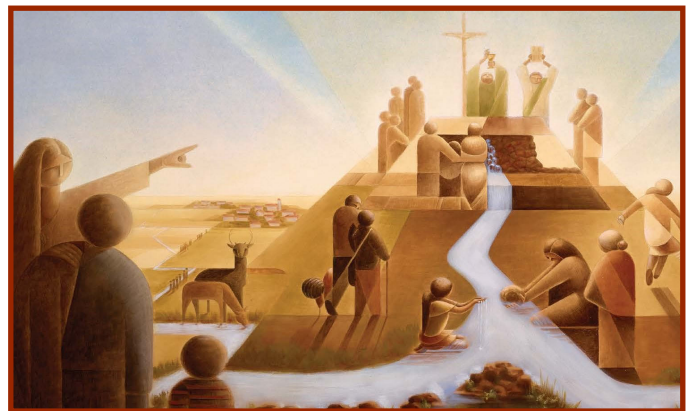
The Father's Day Novena of Masses begins , Sunday, June 17th, 2018

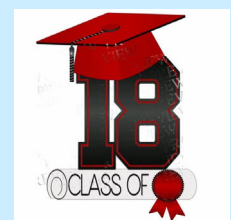

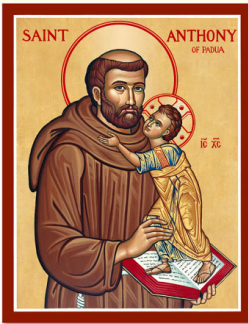

St. Anthony of Padua

St. Anthony of Padua was born August 15, 1195 in Lisbon, Portugal. Anthony joined the order of Franciscan monks and was known for his inspiring homilies and commitment to a life of poverty. We ask St. Anthony to help us find lost or stolen items. According to the story, Anthony had a book of psalms which contained notes

and comments he had made to use in teaching his students. A novice, who had decided to leave the hermitage, took the book with him. Anthony prayed it would be found or returned. The thief returned the book to Anthony and returned to the order. The stolen book is said to be preserved in the Franciscan friary in Bologna. His feast day is celebrated on June 13th as a Doctor of the Church. A legend holds that the Church bells throughout the city rang on their own accord upon his death.

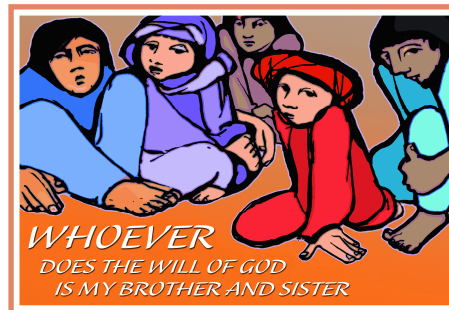

FACT OF LIFE Foster Parents Needed

"When many people think about Los Angeles, they think of celebrities and ocean views. Within the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, we have some of the wealthiest zip codes and some of the poorest in the U.S., too. We have more homeless people and more people incarcerated in Los Angeles County than anywhere in the country. We are one of the top cities for numbers of abortions and victims of human trafficking. And, we have 34,000 children in foster care — the most in the country.

The sheer scale of all of this can seem insurmountable. **We decided to look at the situation in terms of where our parishes could be the most effective, and we realized that our greatest assets are our Catholic families.** Our families are incredibly generous. They want to help, but so many don't know how. Once we began talking to people about fostering, the response has been incredible. Most people don't know that over **20 percent of foster children in Los Angeles are under the age of two.** The need is staggering.
