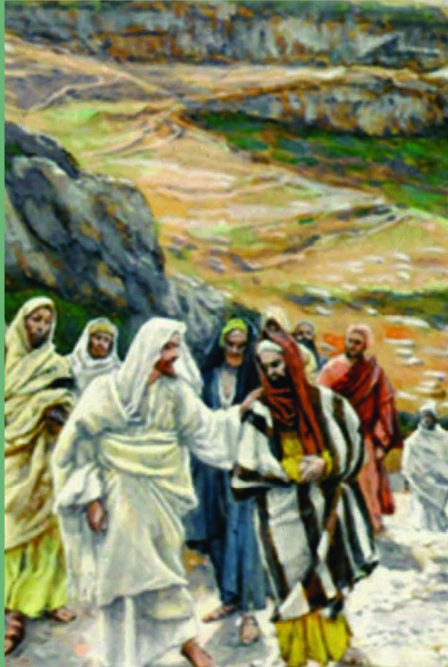

Reflections on Today's Readings:



FOCUS: God chose us in him, before the foundation of the world.

God chooses us, despite our failures and shortcomings, to be his disciples. He sends us out into the world, not on our own, but in the companionship of our brothers and sisters in community. He does not leave us to our own devices, but gives power and authority through his name.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Amos was chosen, taken away from his work as a *shepherd and a dresser of sycamores*, to prophesy to the people of Israel. In writing to the Ephesians, Paul praises God and reminds his listeners that God *chose us in him, before the foundation of the world*. In the Gospel, the now-chosen Twelve are sent out to preach repentance and to bring healing.

Some might also think of a parish mission, a time of focused reflection, usually led by a visiting speaker. Remember the often-quoted line from Mission Impossible, "Your mission, should you choose to accept it"? Sometimes we use the word mission to describe our purpose or goal, what we have been charged to do. Thinking of mission in this way makes our call as Christians clearer. Our mission is to live as Christian people, to share our faith, to be people of service, and to show Christ's love to others in the ways that we live our daily lives. The choice to live as people of mission is ours. How do you, or will you, live as a person of mission?
