Reflections on Today's Readings:



FOCUS: Just as Jesus restored sight to the blind man, our faith in him opens our eyes to truth and eternal life in Christ. The story of Jesus healing the blind man speaks powerfully to us. *Your faith has saved you*, Jesus tells him. The man, with his sight restored, follows Jesus. May our own faith and determination give us sight as well, that we may also know and follow God in our daily lives.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: The prophet Jeremiah proclaims that the Lord keeps his promises, gathering and delivering the people of Israel. In the Letter to the Hebrews, God calls some to be priests, representing the people and following the example set forth by Jesus. Mark's Gospel recounts the story of Jesus healing the blind man on the road from Jericho.

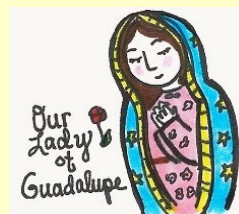

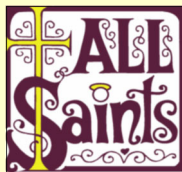

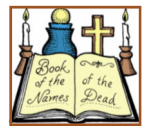

The All Souls Novena begins Friday, November 2nd, All Souls Day, and continues throughout the month of November.

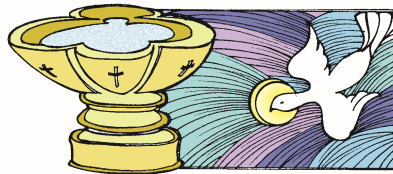
