**Join us for Mass for The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15<sup>th</sup> at 5PM**



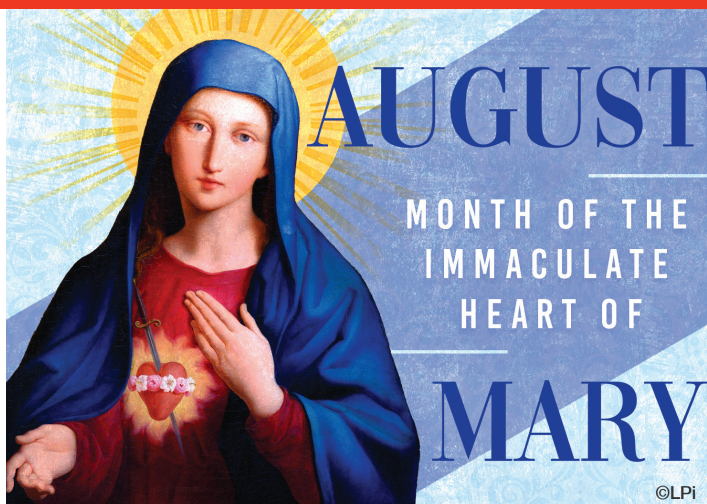

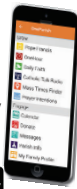
