

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

Summer has dwindled, and once again, we approach that grand celebration of the birth of our Savior. Through intentional preparation, we will know that we will be ready for Him- when the King, our Lord Jesus, returns on the clouds of glory. Please join us every Sunday this Advent season as we worship our Lord.




